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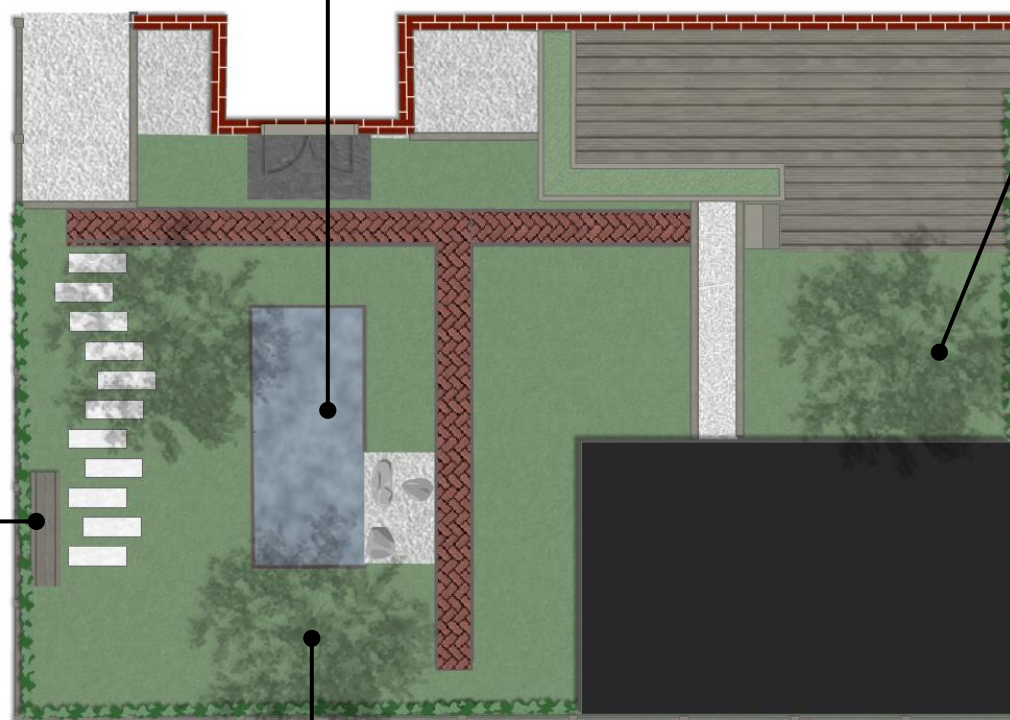
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Water oriented at right angle to pool house and aligned to centre of french doors

New birch tree adds intimacy to raised decking



Bench seat creates new view of garden

Dwarf Birch tree centred to pond creates focal point from house

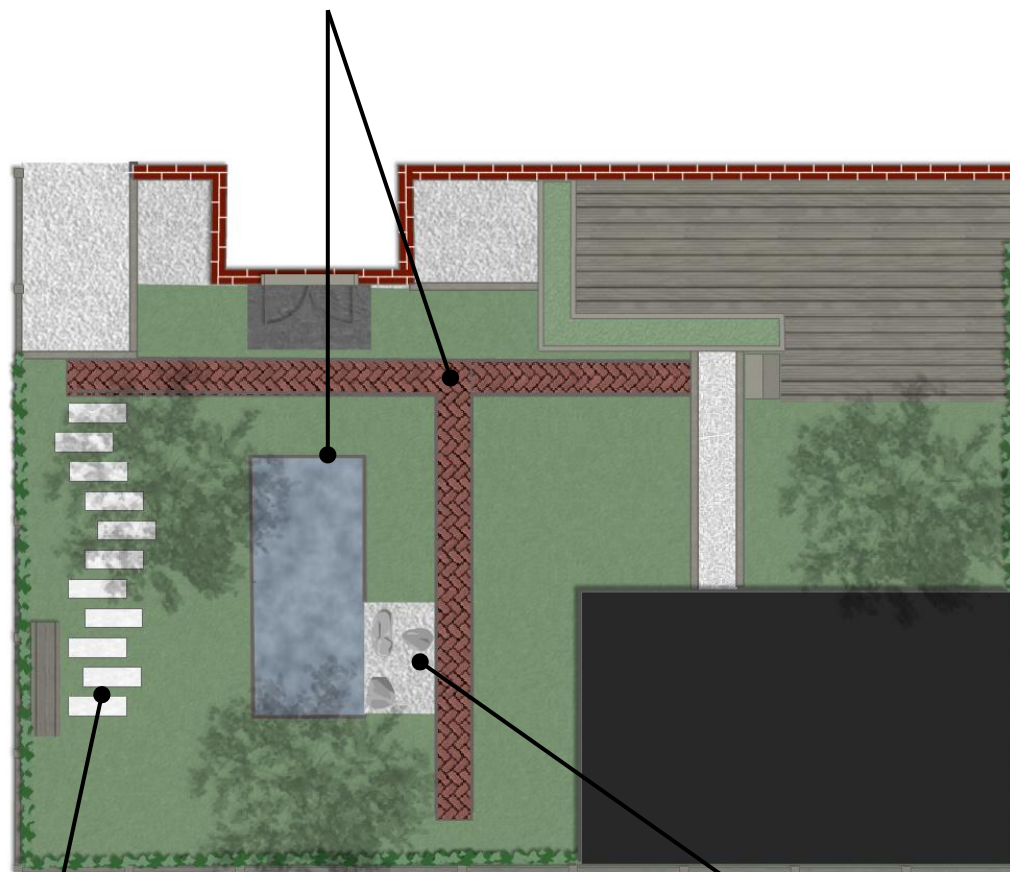
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Pond and paths edged with corten steel - pond edging only around 3.5 sides of the pond to allow for beach area



Secondary material for path to bench in light grey/white pavers.

Beach area with rocks and bog plants creates area into and out of pond for wildlife

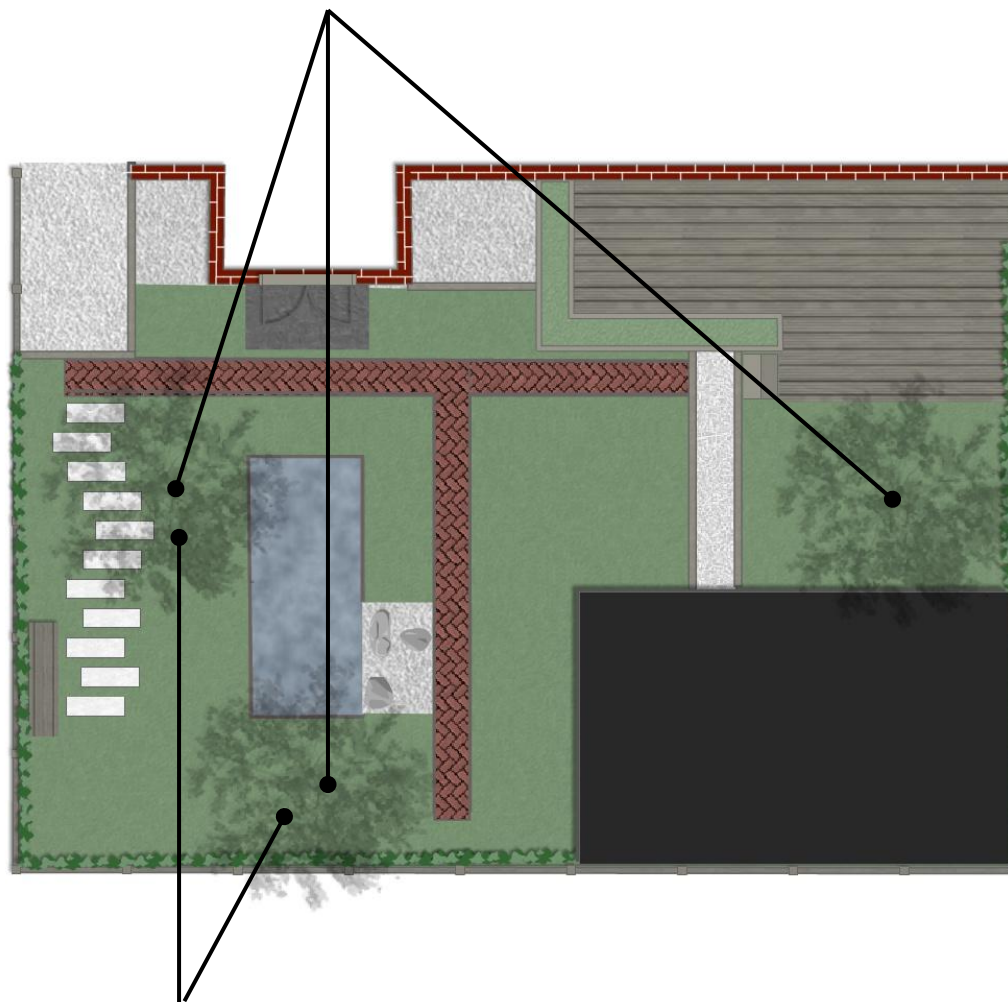
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Three trees in total all dwarf Birch 'Moonbeam' will grow to 3m (h) x 4m (w). They add structure and balance to space and provide focal points drawing eye away from the fence



The three new trees assume the existing tree will be removed. If the existing tree is to be kept, then the two new Birch trees on the left here will not be necessary given the size of the existing mature tree

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More formal planting in shaded area - 2-3 plant varieties focused around Hakonechloa varieties and Alchemilla mollis

Planting in rest of garden is contemporary with muted colours and combinations of grasses and spiky perennials alongside structured shrub balls



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Primary path in slim terracotta bricks to provide warmth to the space and complement the corten edging. Alternative to use anthracite (see link and options in materials)

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Area for dog - please advise if this is not correctly located. Accessible up paths on both sides of pond

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Noticed you have Muscari growing in the beds surrounding raised decking. Subsequently we have not provided planting suggestions for here - please advise if you would like us to add

View from new seat looking at pond and beach/bog area with rocks. Pond to be planted with mix grasses, lillies, Iris and oxygenating plants with marginals in the beach/bog area - to be supplied in final plans



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View from decking - path softened by planting. Borders filled with simple contemporary matrix planting plan. Purples with pops of orange and yellow

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Shrub balls create structure in planting with grasses and spiky perennials adding movement

Images seem to show lavender hedging - to remain.

Additional tree adds balance to space and softens the pool house.
Underplanted with simple mix of Hakonechloa and Alchemilla



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View from pool into lush planting. Mainly shaded area with ferns, hostas and Heuchera



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View from french doors with tree as focal point
